TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament Referee: The tournament shall be played to EN rules. The Tournament Referee will decide on any matter arising during the course of the event. <u>The referee's decision shall be final</u>. **Registration: All teams must be registered by:**

U14 09.30 (matches are due to start at 10.00)

U16 13.30 (matches are due to start at 14.00)

Coaches to sign off on their squad sheets and scorers to sign in at registration. There will be a five-minute warning bell at 9.55 and 13.55 to signal teams to be ready on court the first match of each section.

Teams are made up of – max 12 players and max of 5 match bench officials / coaches / volunteers.

Start of Play: All teams must be on court ready to play at the stated time with at least five players. Captains should toss for the centre pass before the start of play and notify the umpires of the result.

Scorers: Scorers to sit at the allocated score table and agree the score following each goal, using the flip chart to show the score during the match.

Late Arrivals: If a team arrives late on court, for each minute late, the opposition will be awarded 2 goals, if they are on court and in position to play at the correct time. If after 4 minutes the team is not on court, then the game will be given to the opposition. The umpires will be responsible for the timing of the above.

Players arriving late can join the game in a vacant position after a goal is scored and with the permission of the umpires. A reserve, playing because of the late arrival of a player, shall continue to play in that position until half time as per EN rules.

Match Times: A central hooter will indicate the start, half time and end of matches on courts 1 & 2; Court 3 will have its own timer. However, games will start and finish on the umpire's whistle. Matches will be 7 minutes each way, 1 minute at half time and 2 minutes between rounds. Extra time will be allowed to take a penalty shot, if it has been awarded before the final whistle.

INJURY/ILLNESS: No time shall be added on for injury or illness. The substitute should take up the position of the injured player as quickly as possible; the opposition <u>cannot</u> make changes at this time.

PLAYERS AND **BLEEDING:** Please note that Rule 9.3.1 of the official netball rules would allow the umpire to stop the game if she/he saw a player playing on with blood running from an injury. Where no time is allowed for injuries:

if the bleeding is not profuse, the player should be asked to cover the injury at the next interval.

if the bleeding is very heavy, the player will be asked to leave the court for the dressing of the injury, and return according to rule 9.3.1 (after a goal, stoppage or interval) or may be substituted and return after the interval.

In these shorter matches it is not the intention to penalise a team with an injured player and umpires will need to be very aware of the time until the next interval in order to keep a player on court unless it is absolutely necessary to have the injury covered.

Please note:

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM OFFICIALS TO HAVE FIRST AID DRESSINGS AVAILABLE AT THE SIDE OF THE COURT. If they are not available, the substitute would be used, or the team would have to play with only six players.

Scoring: 5 points for a win, 3 points for a draw, 2 points for the losing team if within 5 goals, 1 point for the losing team if scoring <u>over</u> 50% of the opponent's goals. If results show a draw final positions will be decided by goal difference. Then goals for.

Umpires: To be managed by NW Officiating lead Chris McCall

Equipment: Each team will need to provide:	A well-marked ball (size 5)
	Two sets of bibs (in case of colour clash)
	First Aid kits

Umpires/Coaches Responsibilities: Players must not take to the court until all jewellery (including charity bands, watches, or piercings) is removed and fingernails cut short. Umpires will check all teams before the first game.

Liability: NW Netball and Wright Robinson College cannot accept liability in respect of personal injury, which players, officials, or spectators sustain, nor responsibility for any loss of valuables or clothing.

Conduct: A verbal warning will be issued to any person who the umpire feels is behaving in an unacceptable manner. If problems still occur the offending party will be asked to leave the courts for that round. If it persists, the offender will be banned from the side of the courts for the rest of the day. Refusal to leave will result in the game being stopped and 5 points being awarded to the non-offending team.

Spectators: spectators to remain in designated areas during the matches of their club.

(Courts 1 & 2, 1st floor area only when your team is playing – please clear following conclusion of match. Court 3 unfortunately no spectator area).

First Aid: Each team should provide their own first aid kit.

The winning team will advance to the Grand Final and the loser will be eliminated

The winning team will be the first ranked NW team and the losing team will be the second ranked team
