

Under 15 County Head Coach

Job Description

Main Responsibility:

To plan lead and deliver a well-balanced and co-ordinated North West Coaching programme: -

- at County under 15 academy level weekly
- at Pathway positional specific level monthly

in conjunction with the other County Head Coaches & the Pathway Head Coach.

Duties:

- 1. Plan, prepare, deliver and review all training sessions, as a team of coaches and individually.
- 2. Act in accordance of the Codes of Conducts of the County, North West and Manchester Thunder representing the 3 organisations and not individual clubs.
- 3. Allow observations at sessions of Manchester Thunder Director of Netball, Performance Director and Pathway Head Coach and Regional Performance Lead.
- 4. Support County Assistant Coaches
- 5. Attend any Performance related events such as play days, training camps, Thunder sessions as required.
- 6. Encourage a professional, friendly atmosphere ensuring all those involved are properly guided, supervised and supported.
- 7. Carry out pre-activity checks at the start of each session to ensure the venue, equipment and activity are safe and free of hazards,
- 8. Wear North West kit supplied (top only). Neutral bottoms.
- 9. Undertake relevant training courses as appropriate, particularly those provided by England Netball.
- 10. Ensure all sessions are delivered in accordance with England Netball's Safeguarding policy.
- 11. Produce athlete monitoring forms and feedback including monitoring player load (all athletes to do training plans)

Minimum requirements:

- 1. UKCC Level 2 Coach
- 2. DBS Netball within last 12 months
- 3. First Aid Qualification maximum 3 years old
- 4. Current Safeguarding ad Protecting Children's Certificate maximum 3 years old
